Thank you for your continued support of youth programs in our community. On behalf of Booster of Boys and Girls Sports (BOBS), I am submitting this proposal to request funding through the City's Non-Profit Fund for Phase 1 of our snack bar renovation project.

BOBS is a long-standing non-profit organization dedicated to providing affordable youth sports opportunities in Lodi. Each year, we serve over a thousand families through baseball, softball, football, and soccer programs. Our mission is simple: to provide a safe, structured, and positive environment where youth can grow through sports, regardless of financial background. BOBS is a registered 501(c)(3) organization.

The funding requested will support Phase 1 of a much-needed renovation to our snack bar facility. This facility plays a critical role in our operations, serving both as a gathering point for families and as a revenue source that allows us to keep registration costs affordable.

Phase 1 of the project will include:

- Applying epoxy coating to the existing concrete flooring
- Installing proper ventilation
- Installing a three-compartment sink
- Installing a dedicated handwashing sink

These improvements are necessary to meet current health and safety standards while also improving the overall functionality of the space for volunteers and staff.

This project aligns directly with the City of Lodi's strategic goals by improving community facilities, supporting youth recreation, and promoting safe and accessible public spaces.

Investing in this project strengthens an asset that is used by families across the community daily during our sports seasons.

We are requesting funding in the amount of \$5,000 to support Phase 1 of this project. This funding represents a portion of the overall renovation plan, with additional phases and funding sources to follow.

The objectives of this project are to improve safety, increase operational efficiency, and ensure long-term sustainability of our programs. Success will be measured by completion of the Phase 1 improvements, compliance with health standards, increased usability of the facility, and continued positive feedback from the families we serve.

The primary beneficiaries of this project are the youth and families of Lodi. Many of our participants come from working families, and maintaining affordable access to sports is a priority for our organization. The snack bar plays a key role in making that possible by generating revenue that directly supports program costs.
