A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LODI POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CANNABIS TAX FUND GRANT PROGRAM FUNDED BY THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL (CHP), APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF THE GRANT DOCUMENTS BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF LODI, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$67,896.00

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WHEREAS, with the passage of Proposition 64, the Control, Regulate, and Tax Adult Use Marijuana Act (AUMA), in 2016, California voters mandated that the state set aside funding for the California Highway Patrol (CHP) to award grants to local governments and qualified nonprofit organizations for the education, prevention, and enforcement of impaired driving laws pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code Section 34019(f)(3)(B); and

WHEREAS, the Lodi Police Department (LPD) requested grant funding for overtime and benefits to support DUI checkpoints, DUI saturations, and DUI-related trainings; and

WHEREAS, with Council approval, the City of Lodi and California Highway Patrol will enter into an agreement, and the Lodi Police Department will receive \$67,896.00 in grant funding for personnel costs during DUI checkpoints, DUI saturations, and DUI-related trainings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lodi City Council does hereby authorize the Lodi Police Department to participate in the Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program funded by the California Highway Patrol (CHP); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Lodi City Council does hereby authorize the Chief of Police to accept the funding from the California Highway Patrol (CHP); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that funds in the amount of \$67,896.00 be appropriated in the 2026/27 fiscal year for the grant as follows:
