A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CIVICPLUS OF MANHATTAN, KANSAS FOR WEBSITE HOSTING AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES

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WHEREAS, a strong web presence is essential to communicating with residents, businesses, and visitors. A robust online platform, particularly one optimized for mobile, is critical to effective information sharing; and

WHEREAS, in June 2024, the City entered into a five-year Professional Services Agreement with CivicPlus for hosting and management of the City's website; and

WHEREAS, this proposed action would terminate the June 2024 agreement and replace it with a renegotiated three-year Professional Services Agreement that modifies the scope of services by removing an unused module and adding modules the City will actively utilize; and

WHEREAS, a dedicated sub-site for Economic Development will be designed and deployed; and

WHEREAS, enhanced security will be deployed through a Single Sign-On (SSO) solution which is a long-term strategy of the Information Systems Division, consistent with industry best practices, strengthening security through enforcement of stronger authentication standards; and

WHEREAS, a full website redesign is included in the selected package, providing all City departments with the opportunity to review and update their content while modernizing the City's overall web presence; and

WHEREAS, the overall cost for the agreement will be \$63,154.74 for the first year, \$55,177.25 for the second, and \$57,936.12 for the third, with a three-year total not-to-exceed amount of \$176,268.11; and

WHEREAS, the previous agreement would have cost a total of \$242,294.17 over the same three-year period as the renegotiated Professional Services Agreement, representing a savings of \$66,026.06 to the City; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Lodi Municipal Code Section 3.20.077, the Information Technology Manager is authorized to acquire electronic services through negotiation, request for proposals, or competitive bid, with award based on "best value" criteria; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement was negotiated to provide increased service and value through the City's existing vendor through the timeline of the original agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lodi City Council does hereby authorize the Interim City Manager to execute the Professional Services Agreement for website services with CivicPlus of Manhattan, Kansas for the total not-to-exceed amount of \$176,268.11 (10020400.72450); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 6.3q of the City Council Protocol Manual (adopted 11/6/19, Resolution No. 2019-223), the City Attorney is hereby authorized to make minor revisions to the above-referenced document(s) that do not alter the compensation or term, and to make clerical corrections as necessary.
