GOVERNMENT CODE 20516 COST SHARE

WHEREAS, the Unrepresented Employees of the City of Lodi who are not covered by a Memorandum of Understanding; and

WHEREAS, CalPERS requires that the City of Lodi adopt a resolution that specifically identifies the information for unrepresented employees in order to amend the contract with CalPERS to reduce cost share for the following employees;

- Classic and PEPRA members of the Police Executive Management group.
- Reduce cost share to three percent per Government Code 20516.
- Effective, October 12, 2026 or as administratively possible by CalPERS.

WHEREAS, this resolution is an agreement between the City of Lodi and its unrepresented Police Executive Management employee to reduce cost share pursuant to Government Code 20516.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lodi City Council approves this Resolution to amend the existing contract between the City of Lodi and CalPERS under Government Code 20516.
