A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH WEST YOST & ASSOCIATES, INC., OF DAVIS, FOR REGULATORY COMPLIANCE AND PERMITTING SERVICES AT WHITE SLOUGH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY AND RECYCLED WATER LAND APPLICATION PROGRAM

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WHEREAS, the City requires specialized regulatory compliance and permitting support to meet wastewater discharge, monitoring, reporting, and bio solids management requirements at the White Slough Water Pollution Control Facility; and

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Qualifications and, after evaluating seven submittals, determined that West Yost & Associates, Inc., of Davis, is the most qualified firm to provide these services. West Yost has more than 25 years of experience providing wastewater regulatory compliance and permitting services for public agencies throughout California, including extensive work within the Central Valley. Their specialized technical expertise, experienced project team, and successful work on comparable wastewater facilities best meet the City's needs; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends approving the Agreement for Professional Services with West Yost & Associates, Inc., of Davis, to maintain compliance with applicable state and federal requirements, and is structured as a three-year contract for Fiscal Years 2026/27 through 2028/29 in an amount not to exceed \$694,600, with two optional one-year extensions subject to mutual agreement of the parties and future budget appropriations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lodi City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to execute an Agreement for Professional Services with West Yost & Associates, Inc., of Davis, for regulatory compliance and permitting services at the White Slough Water Pollution Control Facility and Recycled Water Land Application Program, in the amount not to exceed \$694,600; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 6.3q of the City Council Protocol Manual (Res. No. 2019-223), the City Attorney is hereby authorized to make minor revisions to the above-referenced document(s) that do not alter the compensation or term, and to make clerical corrections as necessary.
