NOVEMBER 1, 2025 TO JANUARY 1, 2026**

Overnight Shelter

3,552 overnight services provided to 119 clients
59 new clients enrolled to receive overnight and day services
37 clients re-entered to receive overnight and day services

Day Use Shelter

7,286 day services provided to 286 clients
94 new clients enrolled to receive day services only
51 clients re-entered to receive day services only

Services

Breakfast - 3,663 meals provided to 229 clients
Lunch - 4,670 meals provided to 251 clients
Showers - 4,057 showers provided to 164 clients

Client Contributions

38 Clients voluntarily contributed to accomplishing needs at the shelter 286 times
(i.e., clothing organization, cleaning, serving meals, etc.)

Transportation

322 transports provided to 80 clients
**Of these, 22 transports were provided to 19 clients for nonemergency medical needs
in lieu of unnecessarily calling for an ambulance

10 employment positions obtained by 10 clients
