



**LODI ACCESS CENTER CLIENT SERVICES REPORT  
AUGUST 1, 2025 TO OCTOBER 31, 2025**

Overnight Shelter

3,249 overnight services provided to 111 clients  
47 new clients enrolled to receive overnight and day services  
21 clients re-entered to receive overnight and day services

Day Use Shelter

6,783 day services provided to 320 clients  
116 new clients enrolled to receive day services only  
66 clients re-entered to receive day services only

Services

Breakfast - 3,197 meals provided to 252 clients  
Lunch - 3,959 meals provided to 259 clients  
Showers - 3,833 showers provided to 173 clients

Client Contributions

51 Clients voluntarily contributed to accomplishing needs at the shelter 284 times  
(i.e., clothing organization, cleaning, serving meals, etc.)

Transportation

245 transports provided to 77 clients  
\*\*Of these, 19 transports were provided to 16 clients for nonemergency medical needs  
in lieu of unnecessarily calling for an ambulance

122 services provided

25 employment positions obtained by 25 clients
